CONFIRMATION/COMMUNION Young people (YEAR 2) PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

To enroll in the Youth Confirmation Program (2nd year) at Our Lady of Guadalupe Church, all students commit to the following requirements:

- 1. The youth/student must be in the early years of high school between the ages of fourteen (14) and sixteen (16). The Year of Evangelization of Grade 8 is highly recommended for participants to understand the sacrament to be received. - If a young person is in grades 9 to 12 and has not received First Communion, contact the Director of Religious Education (D.A.E)**
- 2. The young person will have to complete the first full school year of Religious Education classes (Pre-Confirmation Year 1 / Communion 1) immediately before entering the Confirmation class (Year 2). The youth may have taken these classes in another Catholic Church. – If it is in another Catholic church, a verification of attendance letter from the other church must be provided to complete the enrollment process.**
- 3. It is very necessary to provide a copy of the BIRTH CERTIFICATE, BAPTISM certificate, COMMUNION certificate at the time of registration, even if the young person was baptized here at Our Lady of Guadalupe.**
- 4. The Confirmation donation is \$50 per student. A minimum fee of fifty percent (50%) is required at the time of registration.**
- 5. It is the responsibility of the father as well as the young man who attends Sunday Mass and feast days (solemnities) at Our Lady of Guadalupe. Attending Mass has an impact on your life by assuming your commitment as a baptized.**

More than 3 unexcused absences will require the student to repeat the year.

In order to celebrate the sacrament of Confirmation in our Church of Our Lady of Guadalupe will perform the following activities by conviction and decision.

***Mass, Holy hour, Retiro.**

***Strong liturgical times: Advent, mission week, posadas, Christmas Mass. Ash Wednesday, Lent Sema of missions, Stations of the Cross, Easter Mass.**

***COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS: Participate in the Christmas program. Help in the breakfast that is held every year to collaborate with our parish. With donations of species and time. Options for your hours: Altar servers, choir, ushers at mass. Assistant to catechists, or other ministries.**
